## GENERAL

1. Alhamdulillah! The Mid - Year examinations were conducted at 55 affiliate madaaris and Pre-Primary Centres, including the Centres of the Greater Edendale Muslim Society (GEMS) outside Pietermaritzburg.
2. Jazaakumullah Khayran to all those who assisted during the examinations, thereby ensuring the coherent completion of the examinations at all centres.
3. We take this opportunity to welcome and say Ahlan wa Sahlan to the afternoon Madrasah established at the Wonder Kids Institute in Sherwood.
4. Alhamdulillah, in addition to the number of Madaaris and Muslim Schools all over South Africa who are using our complete Arabic Series (Book 1 - Book 7), a number of Madaaris in Gauteng and Cape Town are implementing the IEOSA syllabus.
5. Supervision visits were conducted at affiliate madaaris. Observations were made and guidance was given to the Mu`allimaat. In certain instances, model lessons were conducted by the IEOSA advisors.
6. A team from IEOSA was invited to attend the annual "Bismillah Khatam" at the South Coast Madrasah School and presentations on the importance of 'Qur'aanic methodology', 'Parental involvement at home' and the 'Importance of correct recitation of the Noble Qur'aan' were conducted by Mu`allimah Fathima Khan, Mu`allimah Fathima Latiff and myself, respectively.
7. Moulana Muhammad Jhazbhai, the Arabic HOD, was invited to deliver a presentation on the IEOSA Arabic Syllabus at the AMS National Arabic Conference held at Orient Islamic School. Alhamdulillah, the participants found the syllabus to be practical and positive feedback was also given by teachers from schools that are using some of the Arabic Books. Participants requested copies of our Arabic publications which was later forwarded to their schools.
8. Guests from the Islamic Bookshop in Leicester visited the Organisation and gave their input on the various syllabi available in the United Kingdom and the favourable reviews in respect of the IEOSA syllabus, Alhamdulillah.
9. Shaykh Nuruddeen Lemu addressed the students on the 'Importance of Education' at the Crescent Girls' School. Shaykh Nuruddeen is the son of the well known Ayesha Lemu who was a guest of IEOSA in the early 90's and who played a pivotal role in the commencing of the Tahdhib series, Alhamdulillah.
10. Alhamdulillah, during my visit to the United Kingdom in April this year, I was invited to a few Islamic Centres to address committee members on the IEOSA syllabus. I was also requested to conduct the Jumu`ah proceedings at the Oadby Masjid in Leicester.
11. Alhamdulillah, a fair number of Madaaris in various places in the United Kingdom (England) are using our syllabus and we are providing on-going guidelines and annual examination papers to them. For the first time, some of the children at some of these Madaaris are commencing with Qur'aan recitation in Year 1 and Year 2 (Grade 1 and Grade 2), Alhamdulillah.


